Senator Avery and Members of the Committee:

The League of Women Voters of Nebraska supports LB 544 which requires the Secretary of State to develop and publish guidelines for election workers.

This bill will assist poll workers in all 93 Nebraska counties in carrying out their legal responsibilities on election day. It will assist county clerks and election commissioners because they will have to field fewer calls from poll workers on election day if this information is provided to each precinct. It will assist voters by assuring information they receive from election workers is accurate and up to date. Guidelines for election workers can be posted online so poll workers and the public have free access to the information.

The League of Women Voters promotes informed and active participation in government and LB 544 is a cost-effective way to provide citizens with the latest and most accurate election information. We urge the Committee to move this bill to the floor for full debate.
